

MINUTES FROM OCTOBER 18th, 2012

The meeting was called to order by the Treasurer at 7:01. There were no changes to the minutes. A motion was accepted to publish the minutes as printed.

Treasurer's Report:

- We opened with \$765, spent \$14 on an outlet replacement at the Greenhurst entry for the light, leaving a balance of \$751.

President's Report:

- Fairly quiet on that side of the sub-division, but still quite a lot of trash and bottles by the Greenhurst sign. Nick has been mowing in front of the main sign.

Secretary's Report:

- Marina went by Trident Literacy to see how they were doing and found that they have left due to lack of participation of students.
- The fence area was decorated for fall with scarecrows.

Webmaster:

- Will send a list of all county Sheriff e-mail addresses in response to a question from the floor.

Old Business:

- There was no old business to discuss.

New Business:

- Ms. Samm Creech asked if CrimeWatch members would come to the November 7th County Council meeting to support her at the second reading of an Ordinance Repealing Dorchester County Ordinance #10-19 and Amending Dorchester County Zoning and Land Development Standards Ordinance #04-13, by Adding a New "Subsection(s)" to Article X, Section 10.3.1". This proposed amendment would allow a total of ten hens or rabbits to be kept by those with Single Family detached residences or mobile homes on lots that are more than 7,500 square feet or approximately .172 acres with certain restrictions.
- Ms. Creech brought up the situation at 101 Carmon again. She listed loud music, yelling, possible drug deals and careless driving endangering children walking or playing by the street. She stated she believed the two cars involved police scanner radios so when a complaint was called in they were aware and left the street. She has sent 2 letters to DCSD. The first was to Lt Bense on June 25th, 2012 and the second, October 5th to Lt. Phinney. Captain Decker then spoke about some actions we could take to help the Dept. be more aware of the situation, including Emails to Capt. Decker. We will send an Email to Captain Nettles to remind him of the problems and ask him to speak at our next meeting on Nov. 15th.
