

Minutes from November 15, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 7:04PM by Marina.

A motion to accept the minutes from October as printed was made and accepted.

There were 6 guests and Captain Decker present.

The Treasurer's report indicated we have \$751 in our savings account and no outstanding bills.

The President spoke briefly about the County Council's amendment to the Dorchester County Zoning and Land Development Ordinance to allow ten hens or rabbits. She stated that Greenhurst once had a Homeowners Association and this type of livestock was prohibited. She believes that the covenants are still in force as someone has renewed it yearly.

The secretary stated she and the President would decorate the Center area on December 8Th. All welcome to participate.

The Secretary had spoken to Captain Decker about having someone from the Sheriff's Dept. come and speak to our group as it was evident in October's meeting that tempers were frayed by the unwanted activity on Greenhurst and Carmon Streets. He stated he is our liaison and any problems should be phoned or E-Mailed to him. After he spoke a group of neighbors spoke about an incident of theft which happened several months ago. They complained that despite 3 witnesses and a letter to the Sheriff's Dept. No action was taken and the young man suspected is still roaming the neighborhood. Captain Decker promised to check his records and follow up on why this incident was not resolved. Their names are withheld for their protection.

We have resolved to support our neighbors as much as possible and e-mail or call DCSD promptly when we know there are problems.

December update: one of the problem addresses, 107 Greenhurst, has been dealt with by the owner and the tenant has been evicted.
