

## **CRIME WATCH MEETING MINUTES FOR FEBRUARY 20, 2014**

1. Call meeting to order. Ask members if they have read the minutes from last meeting. If there are no corrections or additions call for a motion to accept the minutes as published. There was one typo spotted by the President and the word Secretary's was corrected.
2. Treasurer's Report: Our current balance is \$600.00
3. President's Report: Nothing to report at this time.
4. Webmaster's Report: We have received a few hits on our website <http://www.greenhurstcw.org/>. The problem of loud music and speeding cars around the Miles Rd./Carmon area continues. By the time the Webmaster goes out to look the car has left.
5. Secretary's Report: New St. Patrick's decorations are going up around the First of March. The condition of the greenspace appears to be good, no broken trees or large amounts of trash. The new website "Next Door" continues to grow with about 15 members now.
6. Old Business: None.
7. New Business: Members noticed that a liquor store called Palmetto Spirits has opened next to the Laundromat. We discussed this last year and the store owner denied this was going to happen. Marina called Code Enforcement at that time and they denied receiving any applications for a liquor store. We are concerned about robberies and late night activity at this location.
8. Introduction of guests: Detective Barnhill reported on status of Greenhurst crime. The usual spots were involved: Wendy, Susan and Lisa Streets. A few burglaries, a robbery, altogether quite a few calls were reported. (These can be found on our website)

Our County Representative, David Chinnis also paid us a visit with information about the recent progress of PINE TRACE. An elementary school is planned and a name has been chosen. There was some discussion of children walking to school and crossing Miles Rd. Since most will live less than a mile from the school this is a concern. Mr. Chinnis reported that a roundabout is in the planning stages to take the school traffic off Miles Rd. members were concerned about the proposed location (before the entry to Lakes of Summerville and the Coastal Center).
