

Minutes from MARCH 19, 2015 meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7pm. There were no additions or corrections to the minutes. A motion to accept the minutes as published was made and seconded.

The Treasurer stated there were no donations last month. Our balance is still about \$520 but we will soon be paying for lawn mowing.

No issues reported by the President at this time.

Secretary's report noted that elections will be coming around in June for President, and Treasurer, plus the unfilled position of Coordinator. More discussion of possible slate of candidates at May meeting. She also reported that she had reported an abandoned sofa on Miles Rd. in early March to DOT that had been there since December. She will follow up that call.

The Webmaster updated the Website. He reported there is still a problem of barking dogs coming from Chalmers Lane. He also put in a call to DOT re: new paving that was done recently which has water running away from the drain and standing water will soon be an issue with mosquitos.

David Chinnis visited to bring us up to date on status of paving streets in Greenhurst. The new roundabout construction has been slowed by wet weather. Pine Trace Park is still years away from completion and will be a "green space Park" in the first stages. Maximum number of houses should be 88. Being built by Mungo Homes.

New Business: Members report stray animal problems especially a black Lab. Complaints that when Animal Control is in the Field by the time they respond to messages the animal is long gone, or the homeowner has no way to confine a stray animal until they can come to get it.

Also drainage ditch at Miles and Terry not draining due to debris. A large pothole reported on Carmen and Greenhurst Av. Pavement deteriorating at stop sign on Chalmers Lane.

Mr. Chinnis reported progress on the new Detention Center which will be open in about one year.

Report from Lt. Barnhill: A report of vandalism on Bailey Dr. No other reports. A previous complaint by a member about the police car lights being too bright when folks are trying to pass the church on Wed. after prayer meeting was addressed but still not solved. Lt Barnhill said they are looking for a driver of a 1969 yellow Mustang with a black left fender. This person has been observed speeding thru the neighborhoods. They need a plate number.
