

MINUTES FROM MAY 21, 2015 CW MEETING:

The meeting was called to order by the Treasurer at 7:05. Members were asked if they had additions or corrections to the minutes. There were no changes made and the measure was approved and seconded. There were 13 persons in attendance.

There was some general conversation about a recent police shooting which resulted in death to the civilian. This has been happening all over the country recently and residents are concerned that crime in Summerville has become more violent in the past 2 years.

Lt. Barnhill thanked the Crime Watch members for being pro-active and assisting his department to keep the crime down in our sub-division. He reported on several episodes of front or back doors being kicked in and items stolen from the home. One person who reported a break in on Braly Dr. refused to allow officers to enter his home. He was found to have Marijuana in his car. Also on Braly Dr., a report of persons selling drugs in Wood Oak Trailer Park jumping over the fence to Braly Dr. to escape officers. A report from Beau Court listed robbery of a guitar and other items stolen from a shed. He speculates that petty crime will increase during the summer and advised those who could to invest in an alarm system and security cameras.

The Treasurer reported a balance of \$345. We are paying for mowing the center and some expenses related to maintaining the Website.

The President discussed an accident where her husband fell and she had to call 911 to get help lifting him. Lt Barnhill assured her that the EMS understands that type of call and will come quickly. Both Nick and Rick stated they would come if needed in future but would still need EMS to assess for injury. Discussion of recent fraud phone calls from alleged IRS and Computer repair seem to be happening with high frequency to the elders in Greenhurst. If you can, report the calls. Do not engage in conversation with these people or give them ANY personal information. The Webmaster took a photo of the center decorated for Memorial Day and posted it on the website.

Secretary's Report. Kudos to Mr. and Mrs. Meeks for caring for the Center by planting new flowers and decorations. The Secretary asked if anyone knew the approximate population of Greenhurst because National Night Out requested it. She raised the question of did we want to do anything different this year? She will make arrangements for the Fire truck and Sheriff's Deputy to ride through the neighborhood on Tuesday August 4TH. She was advised to call the Tax office for number of residents. She will put some decorations up for Father's Day 6/24.

Old Business: Discussion was again had about the building at 916 Miles road which is undergoing renovation. What is the zoning there as owner says he will have 6 efficiency apts.

New Business: Marina reminded members that we need to vote at the June meeting for President, and Treasurer. The current incumbents have agreed to continue in their positions if no other persons wish to run. The Secretary raised the question of needing more funds in our account. Some possible solutions were to print flyers and distribute them, and to visit the businesses in Greenhurst to ask for support. This discussion was tabled for the present.

A request for donations was made and the meeting adjourned at 8:07pm
