

MINUTES FROM MAY 18th CRIME WATCH MEETING

Lt. Barnhill indicated that May was a busy time in Greenhurst. He reminded us that school will be out soon and vandalism and other criminal activities usually increase.

- * 24 April: Brailsford - Larceny reported including theft of 5x8 trailer, push mower, pole saw, Back pack blower, 42inch lawnmower and more. Value \$9360.
- * 24 April: Terry - theft from vehicle reported Beretta handgun.
- * 30 April: Braly - burglary, rear door left open. Ps4 game system, Glock 9MM gun, Dell laptop, 2- 32-36 inch flat screen TV's, and prescription drugs stolen. \$2954
