

MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER 2017 MEETING

Dave opened the meeting at 7:00. The minutes were reviewed and no changes were made. A motion to accept them was made and seconded.

The Sherriff reported the saturation team had been in the neighborhood recently.

- On September 20th there was a traffic stop on Greenhurst Ave.
- On August 5th an incident was reported on Susan Drive and another on August 6th. Resident reported 2 stolen guns but no forced entry.
- On August 9th a moped was stolen on Braly Dr. It was a 2013 purple scooter. It was recovered in Berkeley Co.
- A shooting was reported on Carmon St but the case is still under investigation.
- On Bailey Dr. a drunken motorist totaled a vehicle he had taken without permission after hitting a car near the apartments on Bailey.

Deputy Townes spoke to the group about the seatbelt law, reminding us that drivers will be ticketed if children or passengers are not belted.

- Children up to age 6 need a car seat. Do not place young children under 65 lb. or less than 48 inches tall in the front seat as air bags can be deadly.
- He also reminded us that a driver who is impaired by drugs is treated like a drunk driver.
