

Minutes from August 19th Crime Watch Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 PM by the WEBMASTER. He reported that the minutes from last meeting were on line, and introduced our Dorchester County Sheriff Liaison Lieutenant Andy Martin.

LT Martin began his report with the news the crime incidents have risen over the summer to 42 incidents, not including the 19 from TERRY. There were 16 calls from 206 Terry, and 3 more from another address .The calls included 15 information calls, vulnerable adult, suicide and 2 harassment calls. Other calls:
