

Minutes from April 21, 2022 Crime Watch Meeting

Meeting was called to order at 7pm. Accepted March minutes.

Deputy Don Smith, DCSD, attended for LT Martin. He updated us on current crime stats in our community:

- There was an uptick of reports/calls from Greenhurst for 17 Mar-18 Apr.
- There were 14 reports during this period.
- There were 547 patrols in Greenhurst with 8 patrols per shift. Patrols averaged 31 minutes.
- Reports were made from these streets: Brailsford; Braly; Lisa; Susan; Terry, Bailey; Waring; Miley; Dootsie.
- Deputy Smith answered a question about golf carts. If they are legally licensed, they can be operated in the subdivision from daylight to dusk.
- He also discussed the difficulty of catching speeders within a subdivision but said they are able to do so at times.
- He was informed of the missing STOP sign at the intersection of Greenhurst & Terry and said he will make a report on it.
